SCHOLARSHIP ACTIVITY



Objective

To host a Zombie Apocalypse Scholarship Activity, you can integrate it as an "English Assignment + Scholarship Entry" within a "Senior Project Class & English 12 Class". This activity was presented as part of a Scholarship Workshop at Inchelium High School.

- Form Small Groups: Divide participants into small groups.
- Distribute Submissions: Assign different submissions (presumably sample essays or entries for the scholarship) to these small groups.
- Grade Submissions: Have the students within their small groups grade each submission. When coaching student writing, consider criteria such as:
- Assignment: Does the essay or short answer response completely answer the question being asked?
- Focus: Does the writing adhere to the main point or thesis throughout?
- Organization: Does the writing have a clear beginning, middle, and end, and a clear progression of ideas?
- **Support:** Does the writing include evidence and elaboration to explain, clarify, or illustrate the main point?
- Proofreading: Is the writing free of grammar, spelling, and punctuation errors? A suggested recap for coaching writing is: "Assignment first! Focus second! Organization then supports! Proofreading last!".
- Large Group Discussion: Reconvene as a large group to discuss why each small group scored the submissions the way they did. It is suggested to project each essay as the groups present their reasoning.
- Individual Essay Writing: Finally, have students write their own essays for the zombie scholarship.
- **Submission:** Students can then submit their essays to their English teacher for a grade and submit them to Unigo for a potential scholarship. Unigo is a scholarship search engine that can be used for submissions. You can also find "Free Essay Review from Get Schooled" as a resource.
