



## ACT February Study

ACT® is developing an online version of the national ACT® test. As part of that development effort, we are conducting the ACT February Online Study on February 8, 2020 and want to give your school the opportunity to participate.

Participating schools will be able to offer their students in grade 11 the chance to **take the ACT for free, with college-reportable scores.**

### Reasons to Participate

1. Your students in grade 11 can take the ACT for free and receive college-reportable scores. ACT will pay the registration fee for the ACT or the ACT with Writing for participating students.
2. Your school will be an unlisted test center for this test date, and you will test only your own students.
3. Participating schools will be part of an important research study and gain helpful experience with online testing.

**Test Date:** Saturday, February 8, 2020, the regularly scheduled ACT National Test Date

### Study Requirements

- This study involves your school administering **both online and paper versions** of the ACT test.
- All schools must offer the writing test.
- Schools must have **a minimum of 50 students** registered to participate in this study.
- This study is limited to students from your school in **grade 11** only.
- Online testing can only occur on **school-provided Chromebooks in non-tablet mode**. Students cannot use their own personal devices. Please visit [ACT Technical Requirements](#) for more information.
- iPads and other tablets do not meet the requirements for this administration.
- ACT will provide payment vouchers for students at participating schools to register online for the February 8 test date.
- Students will register for the ACT or the ACT with Writing.
- Schools will be responsible for explaining the administration to students and providing vouchers to those who agree to those conditions (additional information will be sent to you to explain next steps).
- ACT will randomly assign students from your school to either the online or paper test. Students will find out their assignment on test day.

**Registration Deadline:** December 6, 2019. Participation will be on a first come, first included basis.
